Mission

Student Activities Council (SAC) provides students with the opportunity to learn skills in leadership by helping to conceive, plan, and implement various events and projects for the school community. Council members serve not only as a representative of their peers but also as a role model to them.

Description of Offices

SAC President: must be a rising junior or senior who has been actively involved in SAC for at least two years; organize and preside over all activities of the student body; preside at all SAC and homeroom representative meetings; delegate responsibilities to other officers; collaborate with Mr. Canniff, school administration, other officers, homeroom representatives, and peers

SAC Secretary: must be a rising junior or senior who has been actively involved in SAC or as a homeroom representative for at least two years; record minutes at all SAC and homeroom representative meetings; collaborate with other officers in planning activities

SAC Treasurer: must be a rising junior or senior who has been actively involved in SAC or as a homeroom representative for at least two years; manage all SAC finances in conjunction with the staff in the school finance office; collaborate with other officers in planning activities

Class President: organize and preside over all activities of the class; preside at all class meetings; attend and contribute to all homeroom representative meetings; attend and contribute to all SAC meetings and events

Class Vice President: serve in conjunction with the class president in carrying out the obligations listed above
